Hydra Project Partner Letter of Agreement

Hydra is an inter-institutional collaboration to build a common, open source framework for multifunction, multi-purpose, repository-powered applications. Hydra's bilimate objective is to produce a community-sourced, sustainable application framework that provides rich and robust repository-powered volutions as an integrated port of an overall digital content nonagement architecture.

The Collaboration and Partnership Memorandum of Understanding of the Hydra Originating Steering Group Members (hereinafter "Hydra MOU") which is attached to this letter agreement and incorporated herein by reference describes the project background, intellectual property licensing and ownership, project membership and governance, the responsibilities of the four <u>Hydra Steering Group members</u> (Stanford University, University of Vurginia, University of Hull, and MediaSheff LLC) and the responsibilities of Hydra Parmetz, As provided in the MOU:

Hydra Partners are institutions, corporations, individuals, or other groups that have committed to contributing to the Hydra community and wish to become fully participating Hydra Partners. They aot only use the Hydra technical framework, but also add to it in at least one of many ways: including: code, analysis, design, support, funding, or other resources. Hydra Partners collectively advance the project and the community for the benefit of all participants. Partners get to attend Hydra Partner meetings, provide input on the community and bechical direction, and represent Hydra to the broader community. Candidates can join Hydra Partners by being moninused by an existing partner to the Steering Group, and being voted in by the Steering Group. Hydra Partners can be voted out by a majority of the Steering Group members. Partner participation is a privilege not a right. New Hydra partners must excent the Partner agreement to be countersigned by a designated representies of the Hydra Steering Group.
