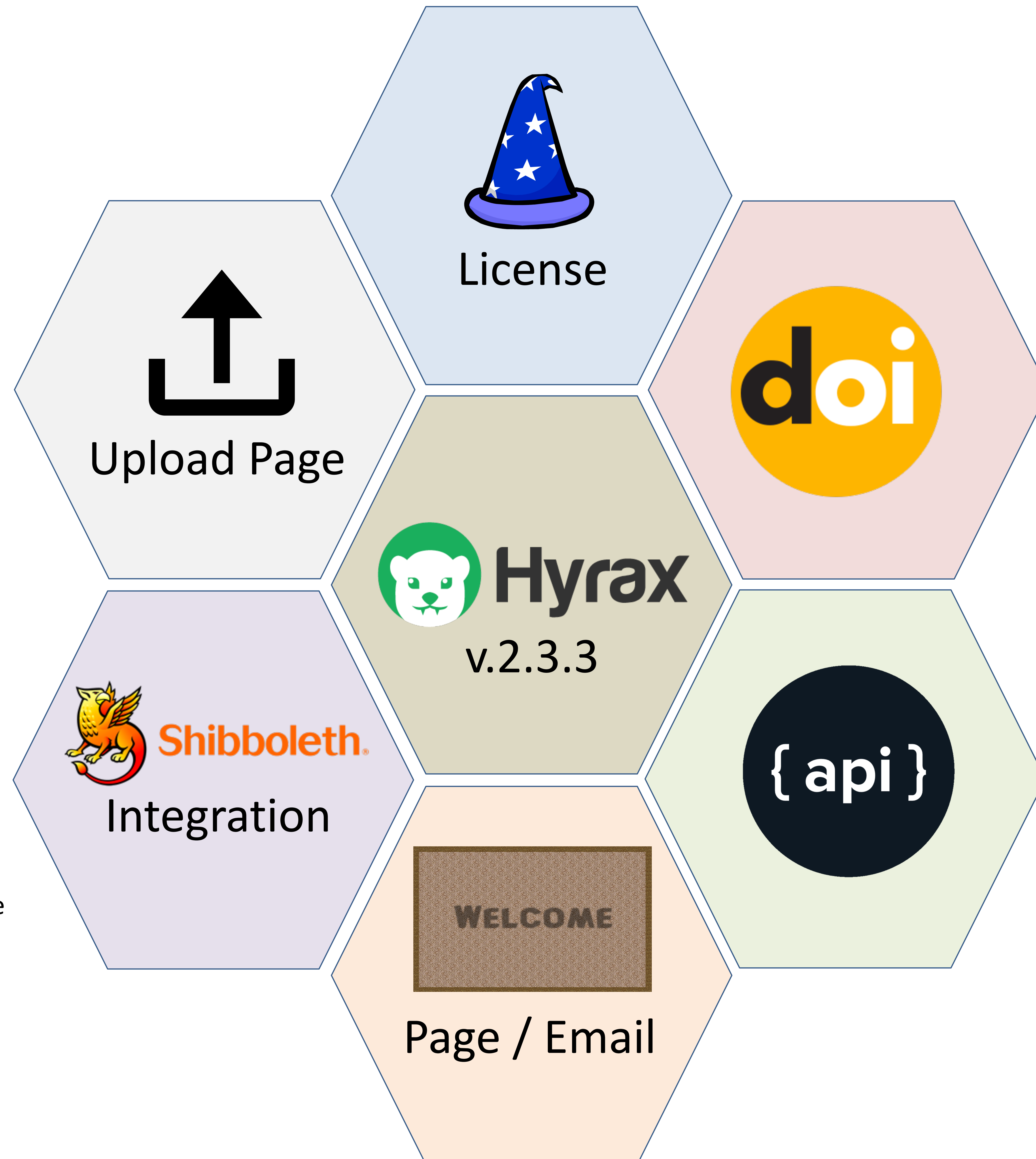
For improved accessibility, Scholar@UC offers a static page for selecting work-type instead of using the modal menu from vanilla Hyrax.

Shibboleth Integration

University of Cincinnati users authenticate for many university resources using Shibboleth. Scholar@UC has accounts for UC users as well as non-affiliated university community members without Shibboleth credentials. The repository includes a custom login view with options for users to select Shibboleth login or local (affiliate) login.

Welcome Page

New users receive a welcome email and are directed to a static welcome page following registration. Implemented with a custom welcome mailer and controllers to show the welcome page contingent on number of logins as well as opt-out functionality.



License Wizard

Scholar@UC includes the public license selector widget from the Institute of Formal and Applied Linguistics. Integrated with the work creation form, the "License Wizard" is customized to include a curated list of licenses for the repository. Selections in the wizard are recorded in the form-select. field

Digital Object Identifiers

Scholar@UC includes DOI (digital object identifier) minting and management using a fork of the hydra-remote_identifier gem. The app previously offered DOIs via EZ-id; following a policy change limiting service to California institutions, we upgraded to mint DOIs via DataCite, also migrating all existing identifiers.

API

Read and write access to Users, Works, and Collections, is now available via a RESTful API implemented with the grape gem. The team plans to conduct batch editing and loading via this new gateway to the repository.
